

Fujifilm invests each year around seven per cent of the consolidated turnover in research and development. We focus our resources on six business areas with significant growth potential: Highly Functional Materials, Healthcare, Document Solutions, Graphic Systems, Optical Devices and Digital Imaging.

The most important research and development unit that drives the technological capabilities of the company continually are the Fujifilm Advanced Research Laboratories, which were opened in 2006 near Tokyo. This laboratory complex brings together scientists and engineers that operate in global teams of innovation. The work areas include organic synthesis, thin multi-layer coatings, precision micromachining, lens design, laser, print and image processing.

The **Tilburg Research Laboratories** in the Netherlands are the European research and development center for membrane and recombinant peptides and are developing leading edge technologies in those areas. The research center cooperates in the areas of membranes for gas separation, ion exchange membranes and recombinant peptides with academic institutions across Europe.






