Subject: Vocas shows new products at IBC 2013

At this year's IBC show in Amsterdam Vocas will show their latest products. The highlights of this year will be the two new universal shoulder base plates, accessories for the Blackmagic Design Cameras and the remote start/stop switch products. Next to these new products Vocas developed several new accessories which we would like to show you at the show. Vocas will be present at the IBC show with its own booth, booth 11.E34.

Based on the success of the 'Base plate for Sony PMW-F5 & F55', Vocas has developed a new universal shoulder base plate. It has several new improvements which makes this 'Universal shoulder base plate' compatible with a lot more cameras. It includes height adjustable front 15mm rails, an integrated dove tail quick release balance plate system and a horizontally adjustable soft rubber shoulder pad. 15mm rails at the back are optional.

Answering the market's demand, Vocas developed the wooden right handgrip with a start/stop switch. This handgrip needs to be connected to the camera with a camera-specific cable which is available for the Sony PMW-F5/F55, Arri Alexa and Canon EOS Cinema cameras. Furthermore the "Remote switch 19mm" is designed to send out a start/stop signal from the comfort of your Vocas leather handgrips.

For the NEX-FS700 and the PMW-F3 Vocas has developed an adapter plate which attaches directly to the bottom side of the camera and allows the use of the Vocas 'Base plate for Sony PMW-F5 & F55' with this camera. Thanks to this adapter the NEX-FS700 and the PMW-F3 can be used with this ergonomic shoulder pad and VCT-14 quick release system.
